
And so, we salute and thank our Discovery Museum team, without which we could not set the sights of this organization so high or take the important risks that stand to benefit our communities the most.



2019 By the Numbers Preliminary unaudited results





New Board Members 2019

We were pleased to welcome two new members to our Board of Directors in 2019.



J. Kevin Nugent is Founder and Director of the Brazelton Institute in the Division of Developmental Medicine at Boston Children's Hospital. He is also Professor Emeritus at the University of Massachusetts at Amherst and Lecturer in Psychology at Harvard Medical School. He has worked at Boston Children's Hospital since 1978, teaching and conducting research on newborn behavior and early parent-infant relations. Dr. Nugent is the author of Your Baby is Speaking to You: A Visual Guide to the Amazing Behaviors of Your Newborn and Growing Baby, the highly acclaimed, top-ten bestselling

book for parents. He has also authored or co-authored 10 books (20 including translations), and has written 22 book chapters and almost 100 scientific papers. Born in Mullingar, Ireland, Dr. Nugent and was educated at St. Finian's College, Mullingar, and later at St. Columban's College, Navan. He earned a degree in Philosophy (summa cum laude) and his doctorate in Developmental Psychology from Boston College.
